'Number and Place Value' is our first focus in Maths. We will be looking at the following areas:  
Recapping number bonds to 10 and 20.  
Identifying tens and units in numbers.  
Addition and subtraction.

In English we will be introducing 'talk for writing' and looking at a Model Text based on 'Camille and the Sunflowers', building up to write our own character description.

Our Science is based on the human body as well as what animals (including humans) need to survive! We will be looking at interesting things such as the human skeleton and the digestive system!

In Geography this term, we will be using maps and atlases to locate and identify different places. We will use simple fieldwork to study our school grounds.

Our Art this term is based on 'colour and shape'. We will be colour mixing, drawing geometric shapes, using natural objects to draw organic shapes, creating sculptures with paper and wire, working as a team

Our first PSHE unit is called 'Being Me in My World.' Within this unit, the children will spend time thinking and talking about the upcoming year; hopes and targets will be shared and each class will create its every own 'learning charter!'  
In RE, the children will be thinking about kindness and will be considering the big question: Is it possible to be kind to everyone all of the time?

PE, Computing and Music

The first sport we will be tackling is football with Mr Avery and Miss Dunton. We will be practicing our skills and our teamwork! We will also be doing exciting Gymnastics lessons with Mr P focussing on rolls and travelling.

In Computing, we will be looking at Data Handling with Mr Poston, organising data into charts and using simple formulae.

In Music, with Mr Avery, we will be continuing with our learning on tuned percussion using the boomwhackers and steel drums.
