Our values act as guides and reminders for our behaviour.

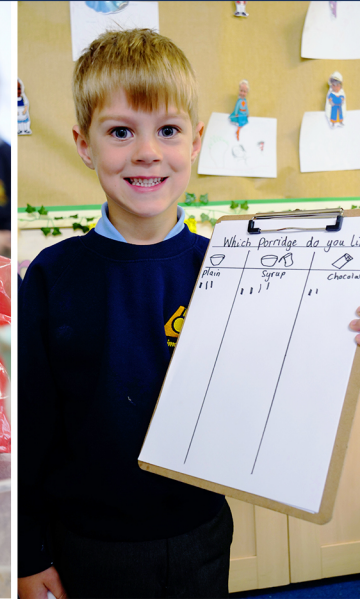

At Langney Primary Academy, we are committed to the provision and investment of wide ranging extra-curricular opportunities for our pupils, of all ages.

We strongly believe that extra-curricular clubs provide the opportunity for children to explore and discover hidden talents; as well as enrich those talents that have already been identified.
