Maths

This half term, your child will be diving into the exciting world of patterns and spatial reasoning! We'll start by exploring repeating patterns, helping them to identify, create, and explore their own pattern rules. Then, we'll move on to understanding position and space. Your child will learn to replicate and build scenes, visualise objects from different positions, and describe where things are. We'll also be giving and following instructions to build, and exploring

how to represent familiar places and story situations on maps.

Phonics

Get ready for some exciting phonics progress! We'll be continuing to reinforce our **Phase 3 sounds and high-frequency words**, ensuring a solid base for reading. This term, we're thrilled to introduce **Phase 4**, a crucial step towards Year 1.

In Phase 4, children will become experts at blending and segmenting longer words that have adjacent consonants, such as 'stop' and 'nest' (with the 'st' sound), and 'tree' and 'train' (with the 'tr' sound). What's more, we'll keep practicing how to read those longer, more complex **polysyllabic words**, building their fluency and confidence.
