

Invaders and Settlers

In history, we will learning about the how the Anglo Saxons invaded and settled in Britain and their way of life.

Our first term in Year 5 is all about the Anglo Saxons.

In our writing lessons, we will be reading and using the book 'Anglo-Saxon Boy' to inspire our own descriptions and diary entries of a battle scene. We will begin this term with a short writing unit, focusing on writing a book review of 'The Tower to the Sun.'



We will begin our Year 5 maths journey in number and place value where we be recognising numbers up to 1,000,000. We will also look at rounding numbers and comparing numbers within this term. We will then move onto to looking at addition and subtraction and the written methods we use for these.



In Spanish we shall be learning all about our families. We will learn how to describe ourselves, our ages and learn how to have conversations.

During our computing lessons we will be looking at various types of hardware and consider how this affects software.

During this Autumn term in PE we will be learning all about Football; including the fundamental ball skills and movements.

Our DT lessons will see us study different bridge types with a view to building our own out of paper straws.

In PSHE lessons, we are going to be thinking about our personal goals and our different roles and responsibilities in our lives. In RE, we are learning about the religion of Hinduism and answering the key question 'What is the best way for a Hindu to show commitment to God?'

In our science lessons, we will be exploring different types of scientific enquiry. This will involve measuring and recording data along with making predictions and writing conclusions.
